

## CONTRACTOR BOND APPLICATION CHECKLIST OPTION #2 SBA BOND PROGRAM

Please provide the following documents to complete your bond application:

- 1. Last three fiscal year end financial statements of the company. If not CPA prepared, internal financial statements are accepted with commitment to upgrade to a CPA financial statement by next fiscal year end.
- 2. A current interim in-house financial statement dated from the latest month end.
- 3. With both the most recent year end financial statement submitted and the interim financial statement submitted provide the following:
  - A. Concurrent A/R aging report
  - B. Concurrent A/P aging report
  - C. Concurrent Bank Statements to verify cash balances
  - D. Concurrent work in progress schedule see online SBA Form 994F
- 4. Financial statement of any related companies along with tax returns for the most recent year end financial statement.
- 5. Company tax returns, including related company tax returns, for past three years.
- 6. Personal tax returns and K1s for past three years on all owners.
- 7. Copy of the bank line of credit agreement.
- 8. Company marketing brochure or web info.
- 9. Copy of Articles of Incorporation and/or Organization whichever applies.
- 10. If an LLC, please submit the Operating Agreement.
- 11. TBG Contractor Questionnaire see online form.
- 12. Reference letters from three (3) owners of your largest projects to date see online form.
- 13. Reference letters from three (3) suppliers see online form.
- 14. Bank reference letter see online form.
- 15. Current Certificate of Insurance.
- 16. Resumes of key personnel.
- 17. Buy-Sell Agreement if one exists.
- 18. Copies of any life insurance pertaining to owners and/or key personnel.
- 19. Bond Request Form see online bid bond and performance & payment bond forms
- 20. Personal financial statement (each individual with 10% or more ownership) SBA Form 413.
- 21. Statement of Personal History SBA Form 912.
- 22. Business Plan, if available. Not necessary but good to have. Template available here
